

Address update checklist

You'd be surprised how many organisations require you to update your address with them upon moving. You will likely need to revise your address details with multiple entities, including updating all your important documents, to ensure that government bodies, financial companies, healthcare providers, and utility providers can continue to reach you at your new address.

Government entities that need to be notified of your new address include:

- DVLA
- Electoral roll
- HM Revenue & Customs
- Department for Work and Pensions
(if you're receiving pensions or benefits)
- Your local council will need to be made aware of the move for council tax billing

Financial institutions also need to be notified of your new address to ensure uninterrupted service and correspondence. These could include:

- Banks
- Credit card providers
- Private pension providers

Healthcare providers need your updated address to ensure you receive reminders or important medical information. Providers to consider include:

- Doctors
- Dentists
- Private health insurance providers

Other things to consider where you'll likely want to update your new home address may include:

- Your employer
- Loyalty reward cards such as Tesco Clubcard or Nectar
- Mobile phone provider
- Saved delivery addresses on shopping websites such as Amazon, ASOS and Vinted
- Gym membership
